7.2 BEST PRACTICES - I

Two Best practices of the college

Title of the practice: Organisation of skill development programmes **Objectives of the practice:**

- Motivating the students to become self reliant
- > Development of skills in agro farming
- Initiatives for accessing the resources of the neighbouring organizations for benefit of the students

The context: Beekeeping, horticulture, livestock farming are some potential areas which can be explored by the educated youths. The college takes the responsibility of motivating the students to these areas and promote necessary skills for pursuing a career in these areas. The college in collaboration with the Bhoroliporiya Kanyaka Bahumukhi Pam aims at organizing programmes for promotion of skills and expertise in such fields.

The practices: The college, as per the objectives of the MoU with the Bhoroliporiya Kanyaka Bahumukhi Pam has been organizing a number of workshop and internship programmes with access to the resources owned by this organization. The resource persons are usually provided by the farm .The students also frequently visit the farm under the supervision of teachers from the college.

Evidence of success: The college has launched its own brand of honey, extracted and packaged by the students of the college under the supervision of the experts from Bhoroliporiya Kanyaka Bahumukhi Pam. Additionally, the college is successfully utilizing the resources of the college for fish farming and horticulture. The training programmes help in developing knowledge and expertise for initiating such enterprises by the college.

Problems encountered and resources required: There is dearth of government fund for carrying out such programmes. Assistance from the concerned government departments, in terms of knowledge and expertise could help the students in a better way in attaining skills in these areas.

7.2 BEST PRACTICES - II

Title of the practice: Regular participation of the college in the assessment process conducted by various agencies

Objectives of the practice:

Regular monitoring of the functions of the college.

The Context: An institution of higher education needs to keep up its endeavor of constant growth. For it all the stake holders are desired to be associated with that process of putting effort of attaining progress on various fronts. Hence it is imperative to assess the level of attainment by the institute at various level and areas, which also offeres the authority ample opportunity to introduce remedial measures as and when required. The college makes attempt to make timely submission of AQAR, registration for NIRF ranking and Academic and Administrative Audit.

The Practices: The college constitutes various committees as per guidelines from the Department of Higher Education, Assam and the UGC, and accomplishes various tasks accordingly. The college also regularly monitors the activities of those committees and keeps the stake holders engaged in the same. It is for this reason that the college has been able to accomplish the mandatory tasks on due time.

Evidence of Success: The college submits the AQAR within stipulated time and regularly organises all the activities pertaining to it. The college has also participated in the NIRF ranking process and completed the Academic and Administrative Audit for the period 2018-2023 by a peer team from the Gauhati University constituted as per guidelines notified by the Vice-Chancellor of the university.

Problems Encountered and resources required: There is constant rise in the number of students and no new posts have been created by the government accordingly. Therefore the teachers are overburdened with work and they have to spare time out of their hectic schedule for the activities.



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
